Valve adjustments are vital to the health of your diesel engine to ensure proper combustion.

Why is a valve adjustment procedure important?

Valve adjustments can prevent a catastrophic failure of a diesel engine. It can prevent a number of problems that hinder an engine's performance and potentially lead to major repairs. This preventive maintenance will help:

- The engine operates efficiently and at full power
- Maximize fuel economy
- Keep exhaust to a minimum and keep the air clean



Valve adjustment is required on Volvo engines after the first 150,000 miles/12 months and then every 300,000 miles/24 months thereafter. Valve cover gasket included. *Note: Some models may require shims for proper valve adjustment at an additional charge. Prices subject to access. Additional time may be required due to conversion.*
