## **Travel Information**

Plan to Arrive in Quebec City on Saturday February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026 and depart on Friday March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

- Flights can be booked into Quebec City Jean Lesage Airport (YQB)
- Alternatively, flights can be booked into Montreal-Trudeau International Airport (YUL). You can then drive to Quebec City which is approximately 170 miles (275km) East of Montreal.

**For United States attendees:** Everyone will need a passport to enter Canada. The same applies to those returning to the U.S. via Air, Land, or Sea.

### **You could be denied entry into Canada if you have:**

- A trial underway
- A warrant for your arrest
- Previous conviction(s)
- Charges pending against you
- An officer has credible information that you committed an offense outside Canada.

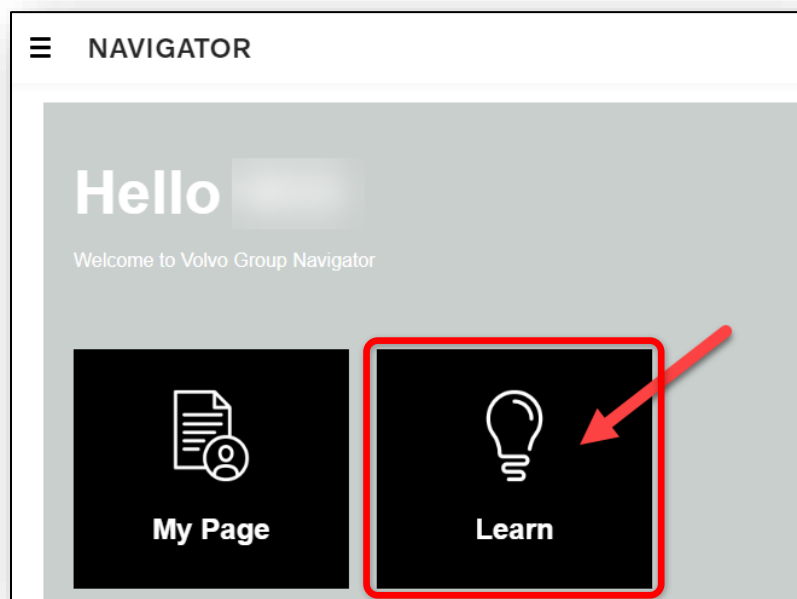
## Pre-Work

**Completion of the pre-work is not mandatory for attendance, but not completing the assigned pre-work will make you ineligible for the Top Tech Prizes.**

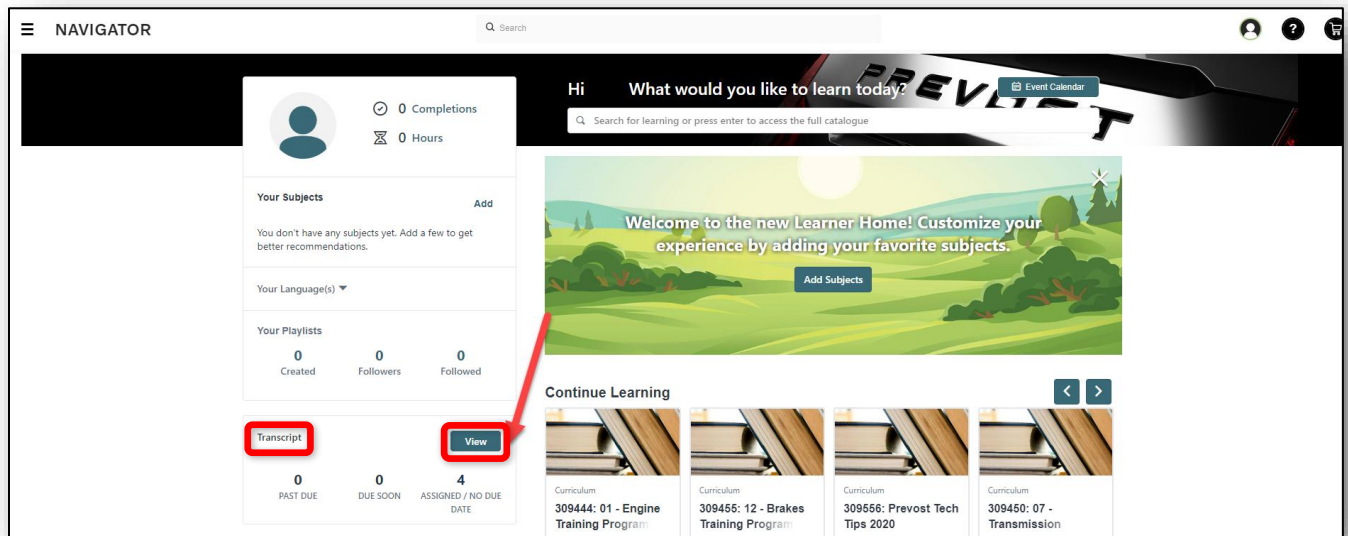
*The following screenshots are examples. Your assigned pre-work will vary depending on the course selections that you have made.*

To access your assigned pre-work for a class, log into your PTI™ then select the **Learn** button.

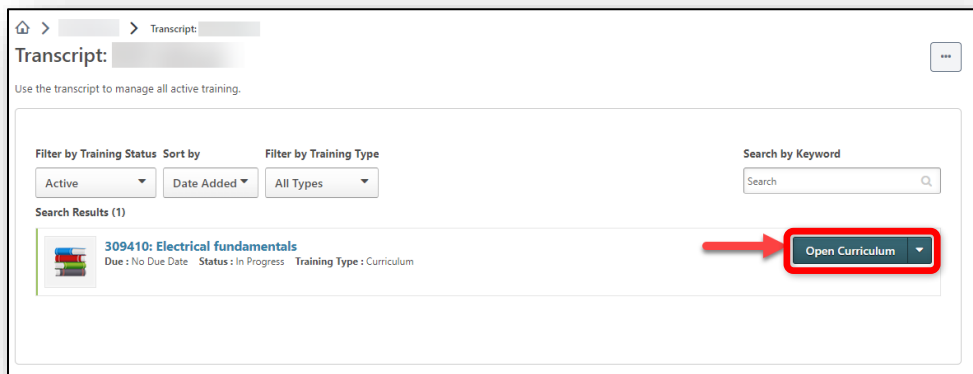

Select the **Open Curriculum** button to launch the curriculum.



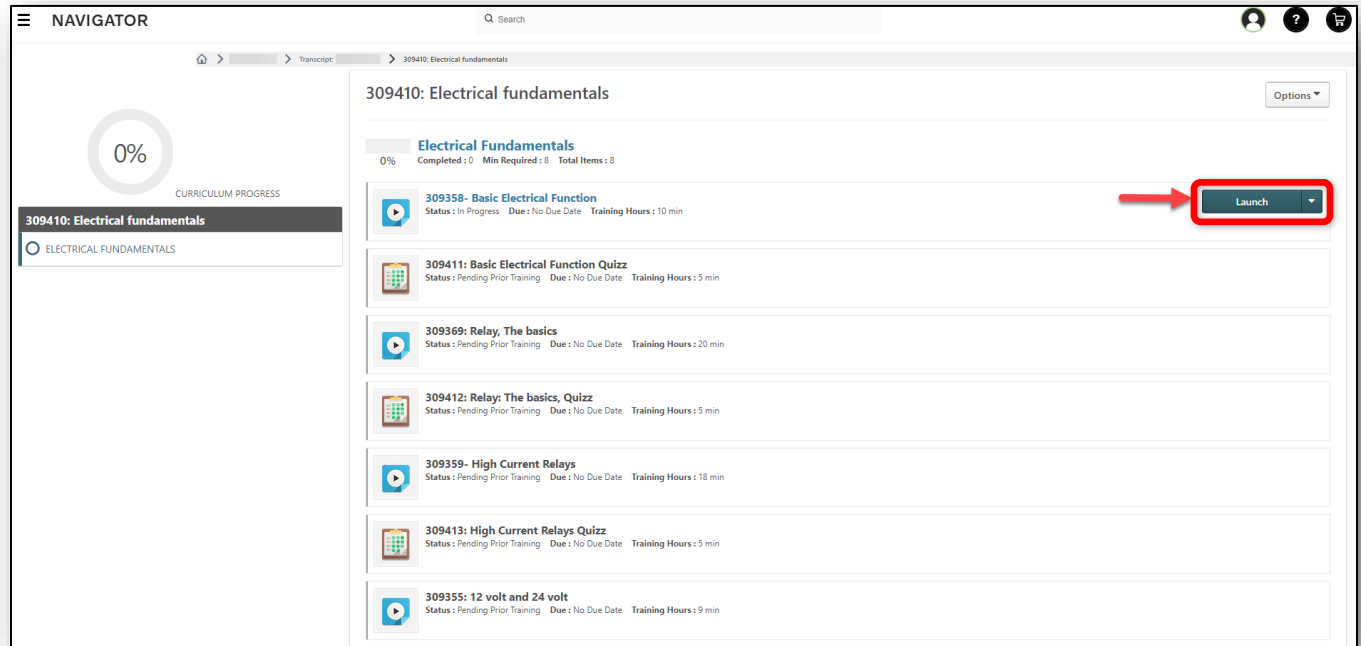
